

Gifts to the Foundation may enable Income Tax Credits

In 2007, the North Dakota Legislature passed a law that is quite advantageous for supporters of the St. Alexius Foundation. This law allows for generous tax credits for individuals and businesses who give specific types of gifts to North Dakota charities.

Individuals must make a qualified deferred gift to a qualified North Dakota charity. The St. Alexius Medical Center Foundation is a qualified charity. The tax credit is 40% of the charitable deduction allowed by the IRS up to a maximum of \$10,000 per year per taxpayer or \$20,000/yr per couple filing jointly. The credit may be carried forward for three additional tax years if it cannot all be used in one year.

For example, a couple enters into a \$200,000 charitable gift annuity agreement with the St. Alexius Foundation. The IRS allows them to deduct \$100,000 from the state of the s



Businesses (C corporations, S corporations, estates, limited liability companies and trusts) that pay ND income tax may take a 40% credit up to a total of \$10,000 for annual gifts to the qualified endowment fund of a qualified North Dakota charity. St. Alexius Medical Center's endowment funds are qualified under this law.
